Important: Per Article XIII, Standards for Divers, Section 4, Refunds of the Orlando Reef Divers Bylaws once a deposit is paid, there shall be no refunds for moneys paid for dive outings. The committed participant is responsible for all unrecoverable trip costs due unless he/she finds a replacement. The only exception is cancellation due to death in the immediate family. All <u>recoverable</u> moneys will be refunded should a portion of a dive outing be canceled by the Club. If an entire trip is canceled by the club, all moneys will be refunded.

Dive, Dive, Derby Dive! With SplashDown Divers May 2 - May 4, 2025



The running of the *Kentucky Derby* is on the first Saturday in May. It is also the traditional kickoff to the Orlando Reef Divers dive season, and it's coming sooner than you think.

\$375(Members) \$388(Non-Members) gets you two nights (double occupancy) at the Hampton Inn Suites, and two, two-tank dives on SplashDown Divers with Captain Dave and his crew. We're reserving the boat for 14 divers.

Tank air or Nitrox is not included. However, you can purchase from the boat directly or bring your own. Aluminum 80cfm Air/Nitrox tank rental is **\$15** per tank; **\$60** for the weekend. Air/Nitrox Steel 100cfm tank rental is **\$20** per tank; **\$80** for the weekend (Air or Nitrox is same price).

Friday, **May 2nd,** we check in at the Hampton Inn Suites. And just kick back and relax. Later, we'll have dinner at a nice local establishment.

Single room supplement: Add Extra **\$173.00** (Queen Double).

Single room supplement: Add Extra \$157.00 (King single).

Saturday, **May 3rd** morning we'll do a two-tank dive trip. Saturday afternoon, we'll have our annual Derby potluck party and watch the *Run for the Roses*.

Sunday, **May 4th** morning we'll do another two-tank dive with SplashDown.

If you've done this trip before, you know it's a great time. SplashDown is a wonderful boat, the crew is awesome, and the company is terrific. This is always a popular trip.

So, get your \$100 deposit payment to the Dive Coordinator as soon as possible.



Philippines 2025!

With Crystal Blue Resort May 10-17. 2025

The price includes 7 nights of lodging (double-occupancy) at the Crystal Blue Resort in Bagalangit, 6 days of diving and Nitrox, and 3 meals a day. Roundtrip transportation to and from the resort from Manila is also included. Airfare to the Philippines and any other travel related fees are not included.

Up to 18 dives include amazing critters and diverse species of corals and fishes. Get your cameras out in order to capture shots of the ten most wanted critters such as pygmy seahorse, blue ring octopus. Expect calm sea, clear visibility and warm waters with temperatures around 80-degree Fahrenheit at 60 feet of water. Expect to see the unexpected. The weather this time of year is relatively dry, sunny and warm.

Pompano Beach Dive

July 19 – 20, 2025, \$297 per member

Join us for an awesome weekend of diving in South Florida!

Hotel: Sands Harbor Resort & Marina, 125 N Riverside Drive, Pompano Beach, FL

Dive shop: South Florida Diving, located in the marina and within walking distance from the hotel entrance. You won't need to move your car the entire weekend!

We have planned a two-tank dive for Saturday afternoon and another two tank dive Sunday morning on the Goliath. Tanks are \$11/tank and Nitrox is \$16/tank (steel tanks are limited and are \$22 per tank; air fills are \$8 and nitrox fills are \$11). You will pay the dive shop directly for your tanks/air fills.

Diving: Most likely drift dives. The boat rides are fairly short and there are lots of species of fish – we typically see turtles, grouper, queen angelfish, lobster and many other countless reef fish.



Roatan is ideally situated along the Mesoamerican Barrier Reef System, the second largest barrier reef in the world. This extensive reef attracts a wide variety of marine animals and feeds the Bay Islands with healthy and diverse populations of fish and other marine creatures, making it a true diver's delight.

The Bay Islands of Honduras consist of eight islands and 53 small cays located off the northern coast of Honduras. Our Roatan diving liveaboard trip in Honduras departs from the dock located at Roatan Yacht Club & Marina. The 7-night charter runs from Saturday to Saturday.

- Diving begins Sunday morning and ends Friday around noon when the Aggressor returns to port.
- Average of up to 27 dives on 7-night charters including night dives.
- Depth Range: 30 130 ft (9m 40m)
- 3-5 mm wetsuit recommended
- Average water temperatures: 78-84F, 25-28C (summer) 75–80F, 24-27C (winter, with possible 72F, 22C drop in January)

4 deluxe double-occupied rooms available. Air is included in this fee; nitrox is available at an additional charge of \$100 paid directly to the boat. Required fees **NOT** included in the trip fee:

- \$40 (\$20 each way) airport transfer fees
- \$145 park fee paid in cash upon boarding liveaboard.

The boarding is between 3:30 and 4:30 May 23rd and check out is 8:00 am on May 30th.

NOTE: Airfare, gratuities and hotel (if you choose to come early) are not included in the liveaboard fee.

A **\$500 deposit** is required to reserve a spot. Remaining payments due as follows: **August 15, 2025 -\$1,000; November 15, 2025 - \$1,000; Final payment of \$481 due January 15, 2026**. Although you can make payments before or on these dates with a check, please use Zelle if possible, to: orlandoreefdiversclub@gmail.com and indicate you are paying for the Roatan trip.
