Cayman Brac Beach Resort – 5/25 – 6/1/24

FASCINATING UPDATE: Since the trip opened to great interest, the small group (10 divers) has been expanded to 18 (eighteen) divers. We already have ELEVEN signed up, and room for SEVEN more at the end of August 2023.

We are going back to the Cayman islands again. Hopefully 2024 will be a good year to do this, and the end of May is early enough to skip any hurricanes. For a little more information you can find the resort online (www.caymanbracbeachresort.com) or on facebook. The diving is handled by Reef Divers Valet Diving, a very short walk from the resort, just past the pool. The picture shows the ocean front and pool, and all the rooms overlook this view (some from the 2nd floor).

Important Details: I've reserved rooms for 18 divers in 9 double occupancy rooms, and the trip includes 7 nights with 3 meals daily, **17 dives**, ground transfers from the Cayman Brac airport, taxes, fees and gratuities (excepting boat tips). They have Nitrox for an additional fee, we will organize this shortly before the trip if you are interested. All for \$2163 for club members. *Note that airfare is not included*.

If interested, the deposit is \$250. Final payment will be early February 2024, although you can make intermittent or early payments if you wish. Extra note, if & when the trip fills, an extra discount will be shared by the group.

Philippines 2025!

With Crystal Blue Resort May 10-17. 2025



For the amazingly low cost of **\$2046** you can dive the beautiful, warm waters of the Philippines. The price includes 7 nights of lodging (double-occupancy) at the Crystal Blue Resort in Bagalangit, 6 days of diving and Nitrox, and 3 meals a day. Roundtrip transportation to and from the resort from Manila is also included. Airfare to the Philippines and any other travel related fees are not included.

Of the up to 18 dives include amazing critters and diverse species of corals and fishes. Get your cameras out in order to capture shots of the ten most wanted critters such as pygmy seahorse, blue ring octopus. Expect calm sea, clear visibility and warm waters with temperatures around 80 degree Fahrenheit at 60 feet of water. Expect to see the unexpected!. The weather this time of year is relatively dry, sunny and warm.

The deposit for the trip witll be \$500 which will guarantee a spot on this fabulous adventure.

The Club is currently planning an international trip to Cayman Brac May 25-June 1, 2024. There are still spots available.


Jack is looking at the possibility of a Phillipines trip in April or May of 2025.

Minutes of the Board Meeting
